



# **The Pulse** BMC Regional Issues Survey

September 2024

#### Methodology

GQR conducted a 15-minute mixed mode survey among 1,200 adults in Baltimore City and Baltimore, Anne Arundel, Harford, Howard, Carroll, and Queen Anne's counties from September 3-9, 2024. Live phone, text-to-web, and online interviews each made up 33 percent of respondents. Respondents were compiled from a representative stratified set and panel sample of the target area's general population.

The data are subject to a margin of error of +/- 2.83 percentage points overall at the 95 percent confidence interval; the margin of error is higher among subgroups and online respondents.

The data are statistically weighted to ensure the sample's regional, age, and gender composition reflects that of Baltimore and the selected surrounding counties.

In this report, results are expressed as percentages unless otherwise noted. Results may not add to 100% due to rounding or multiple responses. Net results cited in the text may not exactly match individual results shown in the charts due to rounding.

GQR conducted oversamples of selected counties to increase statistical confidence.




## Cost of living a major concern everywhere


## Perceptions of economy: split down the middle




#### Education drives economic satisfaction




#### Barrier: Salaries and wages don't meet cost of living







## Majority believe housing costs are a major problem







If you had the opportunity, would you move out of your current community?




#### Older residents, non-college and white residents less likely to say they can buy a home









#### **Roads and Bridges Satisfaction**






## Most believe traffic getting worse, highest in exurbs

Do you believe traffic is getting worse or getting better in your community or staying about the same?





Has the collapse of the Francis Scott Key bridge had a major impact on traffic and travel in this region, a minor impact, not much of an impact or no impact at all?






#### Nearly half willing to use public transportation, higher among young people



How willing would you be to use public transportation at least once a week - are you very willing, somewhat willing, not very willing or not at all willing?


### Transit: Willingness to use varies by jurisdiction

#### Transit: Convenience and safety can bring more people to public transportation


Which ONE or TWO of the following would make you more likely to use public transportation, at least some of the time?


#### The Red Line, a proposed east-west transit line and light-rail through Baltimore and Baltimore County, will significantly improve traffic in this region.






#### One in ten own an EV; four in ten willing purchase one




